This isn't a traditional publishing model. At TWS, we offer something different — 100% of your royalties, 100% of your publishing rights, and 100% of your voice.


We're simply here to make sure your book is as strong, clear, and beautiful as it can be. We work closely with authors to provide everything from editing and design to full production, coaching, and workshops.

But we don't say yes to every book. This packet walks you through the steps so we can both discern whether it's the right fit.

THE PROCESS



1

FILL OUT THE DISCOVERY FORM

Tell us about your book, your goals, and where you are in the process.

2

SUBMIT YOUR MANUSCRIPT

If it seems like a potential fit, we'll ask you to send your manuscript. PDF or Word is fine.

3

THEOLOGICAL + EDITORIAL REVIEW

Before moving forward, one of our trusted reviewers will read your manuscript to assess theological alignment and editing needs. For longer works—or if we don't yet know your voice—there may be a review fee. Shorter works and submissions from past workshop students are often reviewed at no charge.

Note: This process typically takes 4 to 6 weeks, depending on our current workload and the complexity of your manuscript. We appreciate your patience as we prayerfully consider your work.

If things feel aligned and your book is ready (or close to it), we'll set up a time to talk through the publishing path and whether partnering together makes sense.

At TWS, we're selective about what we publish — not because we're exclusive, but because we're committed to protecting the message of grace. Here's a quick look at what we do — and don't — say yes to.

WHAT WE DO PUBLISH...

Finished Work of Christ

Books centered on the completed work of Jesus not works-based effort or earning.

Trinitarian Theology

Messages grounded in grace, union, and the relational nature of Father, Son, and Spirit.

Wholeness & Identity

Writing that calls people into wholeness, true identity, and lasting freedom.

WHAT WE DON'T PUBLISH...

Legalism & Fear-Based Theology

We don't publish messages rooted in separation, fear, shame, or performance-based righteousness.

Transactional "Gospel"

We avoid "do-to-be" frameworks that suggest we earn God's approval through effort, behavior, or striving.

Us vs. Them" Message

We don't align with writing that promotes an "us vs. them" mentality or marginalizes others through religious or moral superiority.

Got questions? Below are real ones from real authors—answered honestly and clearly.

1. Do I keep the rights to my book?

Yes. You'll retain 100% of your publishing rights and royalties. We don't take a percentage or hold anything back. Your message stays yours—we're just here to help bring it to life with excellence.

2. Will my book be published under your imprint?

Yes. If it's a good fit and we decide to move forward, your book will be published under the TWS Publishing imprint. That said, you remain the sole rights holder and author.

3. Is this self-publishing?

Not exactly. While you're investing in your book, this isn't a do-it-yourself model. You're not alone in the process. We walk with you through each step—editing, design, formatting, publishing, and everything in between.

4. What if I'm not finished writing yet?

That's okay. Some authors come to us with a full manuscript, others with a concept and a few chapters. If the message aligns, we'll talk about the next steps—whether that's giving you space to write or connecting you with coaching or editorial support.

5. What makes TWS different from other publishers?

Our foundation is the finished work of Christ. That means we publish books rooted in union, identity, and grace—not fear, shame, or performance-based theology.

And beyond all that—you get me. I'm personally involved with every book we publish. I care about the message and the author behind it. You're not just another project—you matter here.

CONTINUED FAQS

6. How long does the publishing process take?

Most books take about 3 to 6 months from acceptance to publication. Some go faster, some take longer—it depends on the editing needed, where you are in the process, and how quickly we move together. We'll talk through timelines clearly before we begin.

7. Do you accept every book submitted?

No. We're intentional about what we say yes to. If a manuscript doesn't align with the message of the finished work—or if the timing isn't quite right—we'll let you know gently and clearly. We care as much about the person as we do the project.

8. Do you offer help with marketing or launch strategy?

Yes. Our full publishing packages include category and keyword guidance, and we offer optional launch strategy consults for authors who want more personalized help with getting their message out.

9. Can I include my ministry logo?

Absolutely—we just place it inside the book rather than on the back cover. We've found that adding ministry logos to the back can give the impression of co-publishing, which we want to avoid to keep the imprint clear.

The best place for your logo is on the About the Author page, where readers get to know more about your heart and mission. We'll also include your website under your photo on the back cover so it's easy for people to find you.
